



DIRECTIONS FROM DURBAN – RICHARDS BAY - TO KOSI BAY BORDER

There is a shopping centre in Ballito to buy supplies, along with a bottle store.

Please be sure to have a good road map in hand in conjunction with these directions!

- From King Shaka Airport take N2 to Stanger, proceed to the Hluhluwe turnoff,
- Leave Highway here **DO NOT DRIVE TO JOZINI**
- Drive through the small town of Hluhluwe
- follow the R22 Coastal Forest Road
- (there are **MANY** traffic circles and speed bumps of different sizes)
- **KEEP GOING** until you reach a large and final circle (you cannot go straight only left or right) saying Jozini to left and Kwangnase to right
- Turn **RIGHT**. This is the road to Mangusi / Kosi Bay – but it is not signposted as such. However if you ask the locals along the route they will confirm you are on the road to Mangusi. Or **KOSI BAY**
- Travel through the town of Mangusi, this road will take you to the Farazela or Kosi Bay border.

Time wise it is about 4.5 hours – 5 hours depending on stops from King Shaka Airport to the Border.

Parking:

Safe Secure lock up paid for (aprox R40 per day) parking 100M on the left side before the border. Drive up to the border and off load luggage and passengers and then drive back and Park

Border Transfers:

Border transfer times **INN** are 9h30am 13h30pm sharp.

Border Transfer **OUT** on the Sunday is 13h00 and on the Monday at 9h00am
(These will have been booked in advance through the office)

Plus minus another 1 hour from the border to Halo Gaia Camp in 4x4 pick up
